## **Formulary**

- Changed Diphenhydramine max dose to 50mg
- Changed Fentanyl contraindication from "active labor" to "impending delivery"  
The intention is to not give fentanyl in a patient that will deliver within 30 minutes as to not induce respiratory depression in the newborn
- Moved "Transfer Medications" from appendix to formulary for continuity
- Updated TXA dosing with new indication and doing to be 2g IV slow or IO
