# **Dosing and Administration**

#### **ADULT Medications:**

 <u>Dopamine:</u> 400 mg / 250 cc NS infused at 5-20 mcg/kg/min (titrated to effect) IV/IO

#### Amiodarone:

- Bolus: 150mg over 10min IV/IO (100gtts/min. 150mg in 100cc of NS with 10gtts set)
- Maintenance infusion: 1mg/min IV/IO

(40gtts/min. 150mg in 100cc NS with 60gtts set)

- **Epinephrine:** 2-10 mcg/min infusion (10-50 gtts/min, 1mg 1:1,000 in 500 ML NS with 10 drop set)
- <u>Hydroxocobalamin:</u> 5 g IV/IO over 15 minutes

#### In its own IV/IO line

(Run wide open with included drop set)

## • Magnesium Sulfate:

- Breathing Difficulty:

   1 g IV/IO over 20 minutes

  (60gtts/min in 100cc NS w/10gtt set)
- Pre-Eclampsia / Eclampsia:
  4 g IV/IO over 20 minutes
  (60gtts/min in 100cc NS w/10gtt set)

#### • TXA:

o Bolus: 1 g in 100ml NS IV over 10 minutes.

(100 gtts/min with 10 gtts set)

 Maintenance infusion: 1 g in 100ml NS IV over 8 hours. If transport time exceeds 30minutes

(13 gtts/min with 60 gtts set)

PEDIATRIC Medications: Refer to HandTevy

 Dopamine: 400 mg / 250 cc NS infused at 5-20 mcg/kg/min (titrated to effect) IV/IO

## • Amiodarone:

 Bolus: 150mg over 10min IV/IO (100gtts/min. 150mg in 100cc of NS with 10gtts set)

<u>Hydroxocobalamin:</u> 5 g IV/IO over 15 minutes

#### In its own IV/IO line

(Run wide open with included drop set)

 Magnesium Sulfate: 25-50 mg/kg IV/IO over 20 minutes (60qtts/min in 100cc NS w/10qtt set)
