Pharmacology and Actions:

 Atrovent is a anticholinergic bronchodilator that relaxes muscles in the airways and increases air flow to the lungs (bronchodilation)

Indications:

- Bronchospasm associated with acute exacerbations of COPD
- Asthma

Contraindications:

None

Precautions:

Do not neglect Oxygen administration, airway control, and proper ventilation

Administration:

Nebulizer

Side Effects:

• Atrovent is chemically related to Atropine so it may cause minor anticholinergic side effects such as dry mouth, skin flushing, or headache
