ADULT Medications:	PEDIATRIC Medications:
• 10 units IM	

Pharmacology and Actions:

- Normal occurring posterior pituitary hormone
 - o Exerts a selective action on uterine smooth muscle
 - o Stimulates rhythmic contractions of the uterus
 - Increases the frequency of existing contractions
 - o Raises the tone of the uterine musculature
 - o Exerts slight anti-diuretic effect (ADH effect) in large doses

Indications:

Control of postpartum hemorrhage AFTER placental delivery

Contraindications:

• None

Precautions:

• Uterine hypertonicity, tetany, and rupture

Side Effects:

- Hypertensive episodes, subarachnoid bleeding
- Tachycardia, Cardiac dysrhythmias, PVC's
