# **Chest Seal**

#### **Procedure**

**Reference Protocols:** General Trauma

### **Indications**

• All penetrating trauma from neck to belly button

- Open Pneumothorax
- Frothing or bubbling from torso or neck wound

# **Contraindications**

None

# **Precautions**

- Always check for entry/exit wound on back and apply 2<sup>nd</sup> seal
- If chest seal is not available use Fast Patch or improvised with packaging and tape

# **Procedure**

- Ensure wound site is clean enough to ensure proper adhesion of seal
- Peel transparent backing
- Apply to wound site with wound at center of seal
- Firmly press to ensure proper application
- Smooth out all edges
- · Assess back of patient for additional wound
- Monitor patient for tension pneumothorax (refer to needle thoracotomy)
