Indications

• For uncontrolled hemorrhage from

Junctional areas

Other areas not amenable to tourniquet use

Contraindications

Head, neck and torso use is contraindicated

Precautions

None

Procedure

- Identify wound
- Prepare Kerlex
- Identify source of bleeding in wound
- With dressing, apply direct digital pressure to source of bleeding
- While maintaining pressure on bleeding source, continue to pack entire wound track. Multiple dressings may be required
- Apply firm pressure on top of dressings and site for at least 3 minutes
- Secure with pressure bandage or very tightly wrapped dressing
- Reassess for bleeding after application

Complications

Continued blood loss due to lack of pressure application
