All Douglas County EMS providers operate under standing orders (protocols) issued by our Medical Director, Dr. Joshua Korosac. Dr. Korosac is board-certified in Emergency Medicine and practices at the Lawrence Memorial Hospital Emergency Department. Under Kansas statutes, he is the physician responsible for this patient's care, and the on-duty physician at the LMH ED serves as Medical Control. If you wish to take over as lead health care provider and direct our EMS providers as they provide patient care you must comply with all of the following stipulations:

1. Your signature below agrees that you assume medical and legal responsibility for the care of the patient from the time you take over as lead provider until the patient is transferred to the care of a physician in the hospital
2. The medical provider must produce evidence of certification (wallet card or other state license)
3. The medical provider must accompany the patient to the hospital
4. The medical provider must sign the patient care report
5. The medical provider must give a verbal report to the receiving physician on arrival at the hospital
